On Announcing the Names of those who Submitted their Candidacy Applications for the 2018 Presidential Election

And Law No. 22/2014 on Regulating Presidential Elections;

And the Law on Regulating the Exercise of Political Rights promulgated by Law No. 45/2014;

And Law No. 198/2017 on the National Election Authority;

And Decree No. 503/2017 of the President of the Republic on Forming the Board of Directors of the National Election Authority;

And Decree No. 1/2018 of the National Election Authority Calling on Voters to Elect the President of the Republic;

And the Report of the Director of the Executive Body of the Authority, and his Deputies dated January 30, 2018;

And the Approval of the Board of Directors of the National Election Authority in its session held on January 30, 2018.

Has decided

(Article One)

The National Election Authority announces that the following two persons have submitted candidacy applications for the 2018 Presidential election, accompanied by the documents of candidacy and the numbers of their endorsers and supporters listed next to their names:
