Decree No. 3 of 2018 of the National Election Authority

On Announcing Candidacy for the Presidency of the Republic and the Required Documents

The President of the Authority

Upon review of the Constitution;
and Law No. 22 of 2014 on Regulating Presidential Elections;
and the Law on Organizing the Exercise of Political Rights promulgated by Law No. 45 of 2014;
and Law No. 198 of 2017 on the National Election Authority;
and Presidential Decree No. 503 of 2017 on Establishing the Board of Directors of the National Election Authority;
and Decree No. 1 of 2018 of the National Election Authority on Calling on Voters to Elect the President of the Republic;
and upon approval of the Board of Directors of the National Election Authority in its session held on 8 January 2018

Has decided:

Article 1

Candidacy applications shall be submitted from Saturday 20 January 2018 to Monday 29 January 2018 at the headquarters of the National Election Authority located in 110 Kasr Al-Ainy Street, Kasr Al-Nil District, Cairo.

Article 2

The candidacy application shall be submitted on the form prepared for this purpose by the Authority from 9 A.M. to 5 P.M., except for the last day to 2 P.M.

Article 3

The following documents shall be attached to the candidacy application:

- 1- Forms for endorsing or supporting the applicant;
- 2- A copy of the personal identity card (national ID);
- 3- The applicant's birth certificate or a duplicate thereof;
- 4- An official copy of the applicant's educational degree;
- 5- An acknowledgement by the applicant that he/she is an Egyptian citizen from Egyptian parents and that neither he/she, nor any of their parents or spouse hold the nationality of another country;
- 6- The applicant's criminal record;
- 7- A certificate proving that the applicant has performed his military service or has been exempted pursuant to the law;
- 8- The financial disclosure statement referred thereto in Law No. 62 of 1975 on Illicit Gain;

- 9- The medical report issued by the General Department of Specialized Medical Councils on the result of the applicant's medical examination;
- 10- An acknowledgement that the candidate enjoys civic and political rights;
- 11- An acknowledgement that the applicant has not been previously convicted of an offence involving a breach of honor or trust, even if rehabilitated;
- 12- A receipt proving the payment of EGP 20,000 to the NEA's treasury as a deposit;
- 13- Determine the selected domicile where the applicant is notified of all the matters related to NEA's work.

All the papers, acknowledgements and documents submitted by the applicant shall be deemed official in the application of the penal code provisions.

Article 4

This Decree shall be published in the Official Gazette and the competent authorities shall be responsible for its execution.
