

Media Release no. (34) On 19 /05 /2014 Relating to Final Day of Out-of-Country Voting for Egyptians on Monday19 /05 /2014

At 08:15 p.m. on Monday, the final day of out-of-country voting for Egyptians, the turnout exceeded the total number of voters who had participated in the 2012 presidential election, whether in person or by mail - which at that time accounted for 60% of the total number of votes. The number of attendees to vote for the 2014 presidential election has reached 315,000 voters, while the highest turnout record for the first round of the 2012 presidential election was 314,329 voters.

Out-of-country voting will continue until 9:00 p.m. according to each voting location's local time.
